- Protocol for taking intentions for Masses

  - b. If two people agree to have their Mass intentions on the same day, we can double the Mass intentions for that Mass.
  - c. If a person has various people thay would like to offer Masses for, they can combine their intentions into one Mass and have them read in one of the following options:
  - Four names are able to be written for one Mass intention, or
  - ii. For the souls of the family of (John Smith)
  - iii. For the intentions of (John Smith)
