Lent is right around the Corner!

Ash Wednesday is March 5th, 2025! Masses @ 8:30AM w/Holy Infancy school children & our 7:00PM Mass in the evening. **A reminder that Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of Abstinence from all meat products for those 14 years of age and older, and of Fasting for those 18 years of age thru 60—eating only one full meatless meal and two other small snacks!**

Stations of the Cross – Every Friday starting @ 7:00PM beginning March 7th during Lent with some Adoration and Benediction of the Most Blessed Sacrament.

Confessions & Adoration of the Most Blessed Sacrament During Lent – Begin this holy season with a good confession! Confessions and Adoration Saturdays during Lent from 2:45PM – 4:00PM @ Incarnation Church. Monday to Friday: 30 minutes before every daily Mass @ Holy Infancy Church.

Special Day of Adoration – Saturday, March 15th! To enter Lent with more prayer and to make a spiritual bouquet for the Sisters of St. Francis, we will begin @

9:00AM with a morning Mass and Solemn Exposition and continue w/Adoration throughout the day until 4:00PM, w/Solemn Benediction after the Holy Rosary, and before the start of our 4:15PM Vigil Mass.

- A book will be in the entryway of the church to write in your spiritual offering in thanksgiving for the service of the Sisters of St. Francis to our Parish Family!
