Question: Who are the "side kicks" of the four statues on either side of the sanctuary?

Answer: The Four Evangelists — Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John — are traditionally represented by

specific symbols because of both theological and historical associations. Each symbol

corresponds to unique aspects of their Gospel writing, the content of their works, and even

ancient iconography. Here's why each of the Evangelists is represented by these images:

1. Matthew – Winged man or Angel

The symbol represents both the human aspect of Jesus and the divine message

delivered through the Gospel. The Gospel begins with the human genealogy of Jesus.

2. Mark – The Lion

The lion symbolizes Mark because his Gospel begins with the voice of John the Baptist crying

out in the wilderness, likened to a roaring lion.

3. Luke – The Ox or Bull

Lukes Gospel begins with a focus on sacrifice, particularly the story of Zechariah offering

sacrifices in the temple (Luke 1). The ox is traditionally associated with sacrifice and service.

Luke's Gospel is known for emphasizing the compassion, humanity, and the sacrificial aspect of

Jesus life.

4. John – The Eagle

In the prologue to his Gospel, John reflects on the concept of the Word, the Word of God,

capable of dispelling darkness. It was believed that the eagle could stare at the sun without

being blinded, and for this reason, Saint John, who sought to gaze deeply into God, was

attributed this symbol.
